**Name of Event: 'Mission Sahyog' - A Collaborative venture of Jharkhand CSO Forum and Indian School of Development Management (ISDM)**

**To elaborate further it was unanimously decided by the house that in case of non-financial MOU, it would be signed between Jharkhand CSO Forum and ISDM but if a financial MOU is done VB Net Foundation would sign it with ISDM as it is VB Net Foundation who renders the Secretariat support to Jharkhand CSO Forum. ToR also would be developed to chalk out the future course of action.**

Ms. Trisha then elaborated on different phases that the Mission Sahyog is accompanied with. Phase 0 talks about on boarding of **50 NGOs** and understanding these organizations and its working mechanism. Funding was another phase which needs to be started in parallel. Then the next step will be signing of MOU followed by situation and need analysis. For the



Solution Phase, ISDM could connect with some other organizations who have expertise in this domain. A mentor group too could be constituted to provide guidance in this connection. ISDM teams (finance, philanthropy, data sciences, capacity building) will also be involved in this process and bring together the different facets of knowledge together. ISDM also plans to create an open library where all will have access to books and journals for knowledge enhancement.

In the concluding session, ISDM too tried to formulate success indicators for itself. These included:

- ❖ Advocacy on at least 2 policies relevant for the state in context of developmental aura
- ❖ Fund leverage
- ❖ Strengthening GO-NGO Collaboration
- ❖ Changed and empowered picture of Secretariat
- ❖ Added strength to the CSOs who are a part of CSO Forum
- ❖ Shared pool of talents
